

LOSS OF EMPLOYMENT 5/2020

Loss of employment cases soared to **10,048** in May due to the impact from Covid-19. Total LOE figures for 2020 now stand at **31,829**. **Closure of business** remains the leading cause of retrenchment, with the largest contributor to that being the **Wholesale and Retail** sector.

MAY 2020 RETRENCHMENT FIGURES INCREASED BY **17%** M-O-M, MAKING IT THE MONTH WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF CASES IN 2020.

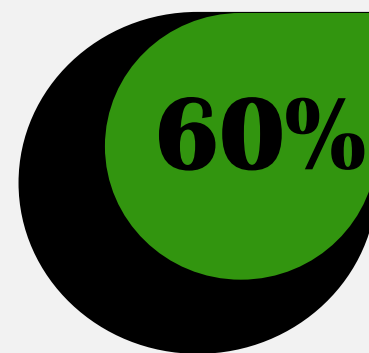


JOB PLACEMENTS 5/2020

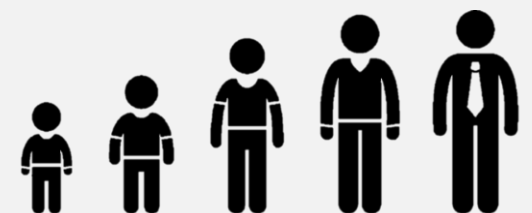
