


- The number of reported UB applications decreased by 13% in Q1 2024 compared to Q4 2023.

- The highest reported LOE claims is in Selangor (28%) followed by










- Rate of Insured Person return to work via ERA has increased by 72% in Q1 2024 compared to Q1 2023.
- The percentage of re-employment is 47% over the number of job loss as at June 26, 2024.
