



- The number of reported UB applications increased by 7% in Q4 2024 compared to Q3 2024.
- Employees waged below RM3,000 recorded 38% cases or 706 applicants.
- Manufacturing industry recorded the highest cases (27%), followed by


Wholesale And Retail Trade (17%).

- The highest reported LOE claims is in Selangor (29%) followed by WP Kuala Lumpur (23%).
- PMET (Professionals, Managers, Executive & Technicians) shows the highest occupation category who were retrenched 62%.
